

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2025-04
APPOINTMENT OF A DELTA COUNTY PRETRIAL SERVICES COMMUNITY ADVISORY BOARD

Recitals

Section 16-4-106(1), C.R.S., authorizes the Chief Judge to establish a community advisory board to develop pretrial services programs.

Delta County has established a pretrial services program. *See* Administrative Order 2021-08. To ensure the continued provision of pretrial services to Delta County and to ensure that the program remains responsive to the needs of the County, it is necessary to appoint a county-specific Community Advisory Board.

To do so also furthers the mission of the pretrial services programs: “[t]o reduce barriers to the pretrial release of persons in custody whose release on bond with appropriate conditions reasonably assures court appearance and public safety....” §16-4-106(3), C.R.S. (2024).

Order

The Court hereby appoints the following individuals, or their designees where indicated, to the Delta County Pretrial Services Community Advisory Board.

- h. Anna Cooling, 7th Judicial District Attorney, or her designee
- i. Patrick Crane, 7th Judicial District Office of the Public Defender, or his designee
- j. Mesa Jetton, Alternative Defense Counsel
- k. Jennifer Schnoes, community-at-large
- l. Juan Gallegos, 7th Judicial District Probation Office

The Community Advisory Board shall evaluate and recommend policies and procedures regarding pretrial services specific to Delta County, and shall make those recommendations to the Court Executive and Chief Judge.
