BUSINESS AFFIDAVIT NOTICE TO PARTIES IN COUNTY COURT

In accordance with C.R.S. 13-1-127, the following rules shall apply concerning the representation of parties in any court proceeding (including Civil Returns):

- Business entities of any sort (including not-for-profit corporations, limited liability companies, limited partnership, limited liability partnerships, unincorporated associations etc.) having more than 3 owners or members must be represented by an attorney.
- 2. For-profit corporations having 3 or fewer shareholders may be represented by an elected officer of the corporation provided the amount at issue is \$25,000.00 or less. They may be represented by a shareholder if the shareholder possesses written authorization of the board of directors.
- 3. Not-for-profit corporations and unincorporated associations having 3 or fewer members may be represented by an elected officer provided the amount at issue is \$25,000.00 or less. A member may represent the corporation or association with written authorization from the governing board of the organization.
- 4. General partnerships having 3 or fewer partners may be represented by a general partner provided the amount at issue is \$25,000.00 or less.
- 5. Limited partnerships and limited liability partnerships having 3 or fewer owners may be represented by a general partner or by an attorney. A limited partner may represent the partnership with the written authorization of the governing board of the partnership provided the amount at issue is \$25,000.00 or less.
- 6. Limited liability companies having 3 or fewer members may be represented by the elected manager of the company (not a property manager or other employee) provided the amount at issue is \$25,000.00 or less. The limited liability company may be represented by a member with the written authorization of the governing board of the company.
- 7. Sole proprietorships may be represented by the sole proprietor or by an attorney.
- 8. In the event the entity is represented by an attorney then the amount by be greater than \$25,000.00 not to exceed the jurisdictional limit of the Court.
