

El Paso County has agreed to provide free parking for jurors who park in the El Paso County parking structures located at 50 East Costilla Street and 255 Sahwatch Street. If you have questions regarding the county garages, you may call 719-520-6511 or 719-520-7741

- 50 East Costilla is located one block SOUTH of the courthouse.
 - This garage provides the most direct access to the courthouse
- 255 Sahwatch is located one block WEST of the courthouse.
 - Parking for jurors in the garage located at 255 Sahwatch Street begins on level 2-WEST, please continue driving until you get to level 2-WEST (drive up 2 ramps). You may need to drive up to the upper levels to find a space.

When you check in for jury service, please have the parking ticket from the county garage ready to present. A validation cannot be provided if you do not present a parking stub from the county garage.

When you arrive at either County garage:

Follow the instructions on the kiosk.

If you have any problems upon entry into or exit from either County garage, please press the HELP button on the kiosk.

If you lose the parking stub from the parking structure – press the ‘lost ticket’ button on the kiosk when leaving the garage.

- If you DO NOT have a validation AND you have lost your parking stub, you will be required to pay the \$11.25 to the County Parking structure to exit the garage. This cannot be refunded or reimbursed.

Lost validations cannot be replaced.

When exiting the garage:

First, scan the parking stub from the garage and then the validation at the kiosk. The gate should open to allow exit.

If you have any issues, please press the HELP button on the kiosk.

We recommend that you DO NOT park at a meter unless you have downloaded the [ParkMobile app](#).

You may not have the opportunity to move your car or add money to the meter once you are checked in for jury service.

Parking at a parking meter may result in a parking ticket from the City of Colorado Springs that the Jury Commissioner cannot resolve.

Validation is not available if you park at a meter, private lot, the City garage, or garage other than the two El Paso County parking structures indicated above.
