This matter comes before the court pursuant to C.R.S. § 19-5-203.

1. Court Findings

The court having jurisdiction of the subject and in the best interests of the child, finds that:

- Personal service and/or service by publication, as provided by law, has been properly executed upon *(name of Respondents)* _____, who is/are the birth/presumed/purported parent(s) of said child; **and**
- The submitted written consent by the person, persons, or agency having authority to execute the same appears to be genuine and valid; **and**
- Through affidavit or sworn testimony, the court finds that that the Respondents have:
 - Died and a death certificate has been filed and received by the Court; **and/or**
 - Decided to relinquish their parental rights and have attached the relevant relinquishment petition, motions, and records with this file; **and/or**
 - Abandoned the child for a period of one year or more; **and/or**
 - Failed without cause to provide reasonable support for said child for a period of one year or more. C.R.S. §§ 19-5-203(1)(d)(II); (1)(j); (1)(k).

2. Court Decree

It is therefore ordered that the parental rights of the Respondents are hereby terminated and the child is available for adoption.
