Are you interested in becoming a Court Visitor? The 20th Judicial District is seeking qualified applicants to serve in the role of Court Visitor in adult guardianship and conservatorship cases. If you are interested in becoming a Court Visitor and would like to apply, please provide the following information and documentation:

- A completed Court Visitor Application
- A cover letter detailing your background and your qualifications to be a Court Visitor, *i.e.*, background in the legal field, interviewing and investigation, social services, psychology, elder issues, etc.
- Two letters of recommendation
- A writing sample of no more than five pages.

Please note that Court Visitors are paid a maximum hourly rate of \$40 hour and are not employees of the Colorado Judicial Branch. Court Visitors will collect payment from case parties except in limited circumstances. Court Visitors are appointed on a case-by-case basis. Before receiving an appointment, new Court Visitors will be required to complete an online and in-person training.
