Administration:

- April meeting minutes were approved. No objections.

Budget Update:

- The budget spreadsheet was reviewed for year-to-date spending. No questions or issues were raised.

Local Board Projects:

- **Funding for CAC Certifications**
 - The Board received an inquiry to fund CAC training courses to increase access to substance abuse treatment services. The Board was open to the Local Board application submission.
- **Local Board Project Applications:**
 - The Local Board applications are due May 31, 2022. Michelle will compile application submissions and send them to the Board members in June. The Board members expressed a desire to have a preliminary discussion and review the submissions prior to the all-day July application interviews. This will be added to the June agenda.

Agency Request Templates-FY2024 Funding Requests: DUE August 5th, 2022

- Michelle will email the agency request templates for FY2024 to Judicial, Department of Corrections, Office of Behavioral Health, Division of Criminal Justice and Denver County Probation.

Legislative Update: HB22-1326 Fentanyl Accountability and Prevention

- As of May 4th, the total impact on the CTB budget is \$1,133,896 in FY2023.
 - \$402,970 to the Department of Human Services for a study on the health effects of criminal penalties related to substance use treatment and prevention services and fentanyl education programs related to treatment and prevention services.
 - \$730,926 to the Judicial Department for probation and probation-related services. Probation to pay for residential treatment for indigent clients.
- The bill permits the CTB to fund drug overdose prevention, opiate antagonists, and non-laboratory synthetic opiate detection tests.

CCJC Conference FY2023

- The Board members held discussion around the potential of holding the 2023 CCJC virtual conference. Michelle will bring updated quote for a virtual conference to the June meeting and the Board will make a final decision.

CTB Funding Impact Evaluation Solicitation

- The solicitation was posted on May 6th, 2022.

 - The pre-bid conference was held; one interested vendor attended.
