#### Administration

- Jeanne moved to approve minutes with a second from Barry. Minutes were approved.

The 4<sup>th</sup> judicial district will hopefully come in August and the 16<sup>th</sup> has also expressed an interest in meeting with the statewide Board. A visit to the Steamboat board will take place July 24<sup>th.</sup>

## **Review of Local Board Requests**

The Board reviewed requests from local boards as to resource deficits and needs they have in their respective communities. More information and follow-up is needed with the local boards before funding will be approved. Situations were identified where specific board members will follow-up with local boards on issues like STIRRT development and Sober Living. These sorts of expenses can't be covered with Correctional Treatment funds, but programs exist across the state that may be able to provide assistance to local communities. The Board determined that it can't fund costs related to staff, contract personnel, or building/facility related costs. These do not fit under statutorily-authorized expenses. Discussion was had around the cost of training treatment providers was had and the Board has deferred an official funding position until next month on the issue of training. The board was verification from any local board receiving funding that it will use the funds only for the authorized population: Clients with a substance-use/co-occurring disorder.

#### **BHO Meeting Review**

The board felt very positive about the recent meeting with representatives from the BHO community. Next steps are to get lists of SUD providers from each BHO and cross-reference that against the existing lists within the criminal justice community. Further action will be discussed after this cross-referencing has been done.
