19th JUDICIAL DISTRICT POLICIES REGARDING SPECIAL BANK ACCOUNTS FOR DEPOSIT OF FUNDS CREATED THROUGH COURT ORDER	

1. On occasion, parties involved in litigation in this judicial district request the court create a special bank account for the deposit of funds pending resolution of their case. The court has assisted the parties with creating such accounts in the past and this process often takes a great deal of staff time and resources. Additionally, experience has shown that monies deposited into these special accounts are frequently withdrawn soon after the account is created, resulting in an insignificant amount of accrued interest.
2. The court believes it is appropriate to set minimum guidelines to be followed whenever the parties request that the court create a special bank account for deposit of funds.
3. The court will not create a bank account to hold funds for this purpose unless the amount to be deposited is fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) or more and the party requesting that an account be created attests that the funds will remain on deposit for a minimum of ninety (90) days from the date of deposit.
4. The guidelines set forth in Paragraph 3 of this order shall not apply to monies deposited with the registry of the court and there shall be no such restrictions on deposits into the court registry. Deposits made into the registry of the court will not accrue interest for the parties.
5. The court reserves the right to deny a request to create a special bank account for good cause shown, notwithstanding that the minimum requirements of Paragraph 3 have been satisfied by the parties.

6. The account created by the court shall be with an FDIC insured financial institution.
