Rule 6.7. Reports

(a) Statutory Authority. The grand jury may submit to the court a report on any matters investigated under its statutory authority.

(b) Reports Not Public -- Except. The report of the grant jury shall not be made public except when required by statute or except that all of the report or a portion thereof may be released if the chief judge of a district court finds such a release will exonerate a person or persons who have requested such a release.

(c) Public Record When. Repealed February 21, 1980, effective March 1, 1980.
