CHAPTER 27

COLORADO RULES OF PROBATE PROCEDURE

Rule 2. Definitions

As used in these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:

- 1. "Documents" means any petition, or application, inventory, claim, accounting, notice or demand for notice, motion, and any other writing which is filed with the Court.
- 2. "Fiduciary" means any personal representative, guardian, conservator, trustee, and special administrator.
- 3. "Accounting" means any written statement that substantially conforms to <u>CPC form 43JDF 942</u> for decedents' estates and <u>guardianships, CPC 29-CR, JDF 885</u> for conservatorships or and to the 1984 version of the Uniform Fiduciary Accounting <u>Principles and accompanying Model Account FormatsStandards</u> as recommended by the Committee on National Fiduciary Accounting Standards.
- 4. "Code" means the "Colorado Probate Code" sections 15-10-101 et seq., C.R.S., as amended.

Rule 31. Accountings

A fiduciary accounting shall contain sufficient information to put the interested <u>particspersons</u> on notice as to all significant transactions affecting administration during the accounting period.

- a) Any accounting filedAll required accountings shall show with reasonable detail the receipts and disbursements for the period covered by the accounting, shall list the assets remaining at the end of the period, and shall describe all other significant transactions affecting administration during the accounting period. Accountings shall be typed or prepared by automated data processing. In any specific case, for good cause shown, the <u>courtCourt</u> may require the fiduciary to produce such vouchers or other supporting evidence of payment as the court may deem sufficient.
- b) Accountings that substantially conform to <u>CPC Form 43JDF</u> <u>942</u> for decedent's estate and guardianships, <u>CPC Form 29</u> <u>CRdecedents' estates</u>, <u>JDF 885</u> for conservatorships, <u>or and</u> to the 1984 version of the Uniform Fiduciary Accounting <u>Principles and accompanying Model Accounts FormatsStandards</u> as recommended by the Committee on National Fiduciary Accounting <u>standardsStandards</u> shall be considered

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Notice of hearing of a petition for approval of an accounting shall be given as required by statute if approval of final accounting is requested, and shall be given as ordered by the court if approval of an interim accounting is requested.
