ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2011-002 (Amended July 19, 2011)

ORDER PERMITTING SERVICE OF PROMISES TO APPEAR BY LAW ENFORCEMENT

WHEREAS an alternative to taking juveniles into temporary custody would be beneficial to the efficacy and efficiency of justice in the Twenty-Second Judicial District; and

WHEREAS consultation with law enforcement representatives occurred March 16, 2011; and

PURSUANT to Colorado Revised Statutes § 19-2-507(5);

The COURT hereby permits law enforcement officers in the Twenty-Second Judicial District to serve a written promise to appear for juvenile proceedings based on any act that would constitute a felony, misdemeanor, or petty offense upon the juvenile and the juvenile's parents, guardian, or legal custodian. A promise to appear shall only be utilized in Juvenile Delinquency matters filed in District Court. A promise to appear shall not be utilized in, or alter any procedure of, juvenile matters that are filed in County Court (i.e. Traffic Offenses, Underage Possession/Consumption of Alcohol, Possession of Marijuana-Two Ounces or Less, etc.).

A promise to appear shall state any charges or potential charges against the juvenile, subject to the discretion and filing of the District Attorney's Office. The promise to appear shall also state the date, time, and place where such juvenile shall be required to answer to potential charges. The promise to appear shall be signed by the juvenile and the juvenile's parent, guardian, or legal custodian. The promise to appear shall be personally served upon the juvenile and the juvenile's parent, guardian, or legal custodian. The date established for the juvenile and the juvenile's parent, guardian, or legal custodian to appear shall not be earlier than two weeks nor later than three weeks after the promise to appear is served upon both the juvenile and the juvenile's parent, guardian, or legal custodian.

Copies of appropriate Promises to Appear, for Montezuma and Dolores counties, are attached to this Order and incorporated by reference.
