Second Judicial District Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Second Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for

a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Morris B. Hoffman, effective May

1, 2021. Nominees David Karpel of Englewood, and Marie Moses and Demetria Trujillo, both of

Denver, were selected by the commission via videoconference on March 5, 2021.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from March 8, 2021, within

which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Second Judicial District

(Denver County).
