## **Fourth Judicial District Court Judge finalists selected** *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Fourth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Jann Patrice DuBois. The vacancy will occur on Oct. 8, 2021. Nominees Samuel Evig and Marika Frady, both of Colorado Springs; and William Moller of Woodland Park were selected by the commission on Aug. 6, 2021.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Aug. 9, 2021, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Fourth Judicial District (El Paso and Teller counties).
