Webex Docket Plans for the 17th Judicial District

Webex Docket Plan for Domestic Relations (DR): Divisions A, B, B1, K, K1, H

Effective: Immediately

- The Domestic Relations divisions will continue to operate all dockets primarily by WebEx, unless a written motion for an in-person hearing is filed and granted by the court.
- **Emergency Hearings:** Discretion for Webex or in-person will be with the Judge hearing the case.

Webex Docket Plan for IV-D Child Support (JV & DR): Division D2

Effective: Immediately

- > Contempt Advisements, Sentencing hearings, Rule 69 hearings: in-person
- > All other hearings: Webex

Webex Docket Plan for Dependency & Neglect (JV): Divisions D, D1, S

Effective: January 3, 2022

- ➤ Initial Shelter hearing: Webex
- > 2nd Advisement hearings, adjudicatory hearings, dispositional hearings: In person
- **Permanency planning hearings, review hearings, post-termination hearings:** Webex
- **Pre-trial conferences**: in person
- (half day or longer) Termination hearings, Contested APR, Contested Placement, Contested Adoption hearings: in person (default), unless written motion for Webex is filed and granted
- Contested hearings less than a half day: Webex (default)
- Court Trials and Jury Trials: in person
- Cases where ADA asserted: Judicial Officer will have discretion to determine whether hearing is in person or by Webex
- > ICWA Court: Webex
- Family Treatment Court: in person
- For Webex-authorized hearings, parties MUST appear by video (cell phone app or laptop/computer); calling in only by phone will not be allowed.

Post-COVID Docket Plan for Juvenile Delinquency (JD): Divisions D, D2, S

Effective: January 3, 2022

- **Detention Hearings:** in person for youth; Hybrid option for parents
- > Summons Advisements: Webex
- Preliminary Hearings and Revocation Hearings: Webex, unless court is notified otherwise
- Motions hearings and Restitution hearings: in person
- > Pre-trial conference: Webex (default), unless a written motion for in person is filed and granted
- Review hearings, all other hearings: Webex (default), unless a written motion for in person is filed and granted
- Court Trials, Jury Trials: in person
- > ACT: Webex, unless Judge determines that youth/parent need to appear in person
- For Webex-authorized hearings, parties MUST appear by video (cell phone app or laptop/computer); calling in only by phone will not be allowed.

Post-COVID Docket Plan for Truancy (TR): Division D2

Effective Immediately

- Truancy Advisements: in-person
- **Review hearings:** Webex, unless youth is not in compliance
- > Contempt hearings: in person
- For Webex-authorized hearings, parties MUST appear by video (cell phone app or laptop/computer; calling in only by phone will not be allowed.

Post-COVID Docket Plan for Adoption (JA): Divisions D, D1, S

Effective Immediately

> Judicial Officer will have discretion to determine whether hearing is in person or by Webex

Post-COVID Docket Plan for District Civil (CV): Divisions A, C, W

Effective Immediately

- Case Management Conference, Trial Management Conference, Discovery Dispute conference:
 Webex
- > Structured settlement / annuity conversion hearing: Webex
- Initial FED hearings, replevin hearings on orders to show cause, petitions to seal: Webex
- Pre-Trial Readiness Conference: In person, though parties may request converting the conference to Webex if they timely provide required materials in advance (jury instructions, exhibits, etc.)
- ➤ Hearings on all other motions (including Rule 69 hearings): In person
- > Trials (court and jury), including FED trials: In person
- > All other hearings not listed above: In Person
- ➤ The Court may make exceptions to the plan for special circumstances or when deemed appropriate.

Post-COVID Docket Plan for District Criminal (CR): Divisions E, F, G, L, M, Q, T

Effective Immediately

- > All hearings, court appearances and trials: in person
- Courtrooms will be open to the public.
- Webex will only be available for: 1) defendants on bond or by writ; 2) counsel; and 3) those who qualify under the Victim Rights Act, who have requested and have been authorized, in advance, by the CR division.

Post-COVID Docket Plan for Broomfield: County & District

Effective Immediately

Division 1:

- All appearances in **Misdemeanor, Traffic & DUI cases**: in-person
- > All appearances in Felony cases (in Div 1): Webex
- First appearances at the Broomfield Detention Center: Webex
- Video writs will also be used for any in custody appearances other than trial
- County Civil hearings: in-person, unless parties agree to appear virtually
- County Civil contempt hearings: in-person

Division A:

- > JD & CR sentencings and trials: in-person
- > JD & CR motions hearings: in-person, if requested by any party; otherwise, Webex
- > JV terminations and APR: in person, unless any individual or party requests to be virtual for health reasons.
- > All Probate (PR) hearings: Webex
- All other hearings: Webex, unless requested to be in-person, and then the court will decide on a case-by-case basis.

Division B:

- Civil Cases (CV):
 - **Trials**: in-person
 - All contempt proceedings: in-person
 - All restraining order and injunction proceedings: in-person, unless the parties agree to conduct the proceedings via Webex;
 - The Court retains discretion to utilize Webex in all other civil proceedings.
- Domestic Relations (DR):
 - All contempt proceedings: in-person;
 - All contested permanent orders hearings in dissolution of marriage & allocation of
 parental responsibilities cases: in-person, unless the parties agree to conduct the
 proceedings via Webex;
 - The Court retains discretion to utilize Webex in all other proceedings governed by Title 14,
 Colorado Revised Statutes.
- > Mental Health (MH): Webex, unless a party objects and requests that a hearing be held in-person

Division C:

- All appearances in **Criminal and Traffic** docket: in person
- Video writs will be used for any in-custody appearances
- ➤ Morning jail advisements: Webex
- ➤ All **TPO/PPO** hearings: in person
- > Small claims cases: in person
- Name change cases: Webex
- Non-contested DR hearings and status conferences: Webex
- All other DR hearings will be consistent with Judge Kiesnowski's DR case management order

Post-COVID Docket for Mental Health (MH) and Probate (PR): Divisions T, T1

Effective Immediately

- ➤ All Probate and Mental Health hearings: Webex
- The Court will authorize an in person hearing if the Parties request it and the court finds good cause.

Post-COVID Docket for County Civil (C): Divisions 1, 8

- Eviction and Court trials by default: Webex, unless otherwise ordered by the Court.
 - Parties appearing virtually must use the WebEx application to allow both video and audio.
 Calling in only by phone is not authorized.
- > Contempt and Garnishment Liability Hearings: Defendants should appear in person.
- **Replevins**: Pro se parties (people representing themselves) must appear in person.
- ➤ All Courtrooms will remain open if a party cannot appear virtually.

Post-COVID Docket for County Criminal (T, R, M, CR): Divisions 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8

- > All non-testimonial hearings: Webex.
 - Parties must use the WebEx application that will allow for both audio and video. Call ins by phone only are not authorized, those parties must appear in person if they cannot use the WebEx application.
- > Testimonial hearings, status conferences and jury trials: in-person, unless otherwise ordered by the Court.
- Any Defendant charged with a crime of domestic violence: in person, unless otherwise ordered by the Court.
- > All Courtrooms will remain open if a party cannot appear virtually.

Division R:

> All Traffic (T) cases: in-person

> All Traffic Infraction (R) cases: Webex

Division R2:

Preliminary Hearings: in-person

> In-custody matters: Webex

> All other hearings: Webex

The Court may make exceptions to the plan when deemed appropriate

Division R3:

> Adams County Drug Court: hybrid

Adams County Court for Veterans: hybrid

Post-COVID Docket for Small Claims (S): Division S1
