Summit County Court judge finalists selected Governor to appoint new county court judge

The Fifth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a Summit County court judgeship, effective January 4, 2025, created by the Honorable Edward J. Casias not standing for re-election in 2024. Nominees Julia A. Chamberlin, Robert N. Gregory, and Tracie J. S. Hulbert, all of Breckenridge, were selected in a meeting on July 24, 2024, at the Summit County Justice Center in Breckenridge, Colorado.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from July 25, 2024, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Kiowa County.
