Correction*: Second Judicial District announces Two District Court vacancies

Commission sets date to select nominees

The Second Judicial District Nominating Commission will meet on Aug. 13, 2024, at the Denver City and County Building to interview and select nominees for appointment by the governor to the office of district judge for the Second Judicial District (Denver County). The vacancies will be created by the retirements of the Hon. David H. Goldberg and the Hon. Jennifer B. Torrington. The vacancies both will occur on Jan. 14, 2025.

To be eligible, the applicant must be a qualified elector of the Second Judicial District at the time of investiture and must have been admitted to the practice of law in Colorado for five years. The current annual salary for this position is \$193,008. The initial term of office of a district judge is a provisional term of two years; thereafter, the incumbent district judge, if retained by the voters, has a term of six years.

The completed application must be e-mailed to the address listed in the instructions below no later

than 4 p.m. on July 29, 2024. Late applications will not be considered. Any person wishing to suggest a candidate to fill the vacancy may do so by letter to be submitted to any member of the nominating commission, with a copy to the ex officio chair, no later than July 22, 2024.
