

CHIEF JUDGE DIRECTIVE 18-03

ORDER REGARDING REQUESTS FOR OFFICIAL COURT RECORDS

Pursuant to CJD 05-03(V)(E), each Judicial District shall create a policy outlining the procedures for requesting transcripts, tapes or digital recordings.

It is the policy of the Eleventh Judicial District that transcripts are the official record of the Court and any digital audio recordings are deemed as tools used to complete the official record.

As technology advances, microphones have become more sensitive and are able to capture recordings that are not part of the official court record and should not be disseminated by the Court. Additionally, the Court does not have the necessary technology to redact victim information from audio recordings, which is a requirement of Chief Justice Directive 05-01. Finally, the Courts of this District do not have the resources to copy audio recordings.

Therefore the Courts of this District will not provide audio recordings of court proceedings.

Pursuant to Chief Justice Directive 05-03, the Court shall not accommodate requests to listen to recorded proceedings.
