

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER No. 2007-03 LARIMER COUNTY COURT

Subject: Boundary change for filing of misdemeanor, traffic, and petty offense cases in Fort Collins and Loveland

WHEREAS Larimer County is experiencing significant population growth most of which is in the southern or southeastern part of the county;

WHEREAS there will be two county court judges assigned to the Loveland Courthouse effective June 18, 2007; and

WHEREAS it is appropriate to maintain a relatively equal caseload among the four county court judges, and to do so requires changing the current boundary line which is County Road 32 (Carpenter Road),

It is hereby ordered that the boundary line for case filings shall be changed to Harmony Road (County Road 74).

It is further ordered that all cases involving alleged offenses occurring south of Harmony Road shall be filed as Loveland cases and all cases involving alleged offenses occurring on or north of Harmony Road shall be filed as Fort Collins cases.

It is further ordered that all arraignments shall continue to be held in the First Appearance Center (Division 1A) at the Justice Center in Fort Collins.

It is further ordered that the Clerk of the Court shall provide immediate notice to the affected law enforcement agencies (Fort Collins Police Services exempted), Probation Office, District Attorney, and Larimer County Bar Association.

It is further ordered that this order shall take effect for all offenses occurring on or after June 1, 2007.
