There are misdemeanor and traffic cases in Larimer County Court with an unpaid Outstanding Judgment Warrant (OJW) that was assessed prior to January 1, 2005, and that have been closed due to the Auto Expiring of a Failure to Appear or Failure to Comply warrant. However, DMV has deleted all unpaid OJW's from their system that were issued prior to January 1, 2005.

To clean up old receivables that are minimal in amount and likely no longer collectible, the Clerk of Court or her designee may remove any unpaid OJW from a case where the warrant has expired and it appears no further action will be taken if a query determines that the case satisfies the criteria below:

- 1. An OJW fee was assessed prior to Jan 1, 2005, when an FTA or FTC warrant was issued.
- 2. The FTA or FTC warrant auto expired and the case has been closed
- 3. The defendant never appeared on the charges
- 4. There is no active warrant

Any unpaid OJW fee found on cases that meet the above criteria will be removed from the receivables by the Clerk of Court or a Supervisor as designated by the Clerk of Court.
