Colorado Revised Statute §13-6-218 provides the authority for County Court Judges to be assigned by the Chief Justice of the Colorado Supreme Court to perform duties in any District Court. Chief Justice Directive 95-01 provides authority from the Chief Justice of the Colorado Supreme Court to the Chief Judge of a Judicial District to delegate authority to County Court Judges to hear or decide all or any part of a case.

The Eighth Judicial District utilizes judicial officers to answer after-hour emergency requests from law enforcement and the Department of Human Services. The Judges of the Larimer County Court are qualified to make the necessary after-hour determinations presented under Colorado Revised Statutes Title 19: Children's Code. Therefore, it is hereby ordered pursuant to Colorado Revised Statute §13-6-218 and Chief Justice Directive 95-01(4) that during after-hour's emergencies, County Court Judges have full authority to preside over matters related to Colorado Revised Statutes Title 19.
