### Rule 56. Summary Judgment and Rulings on Questions of Law

## (a) - (g) [NO CHANGE]

(h) Determination of a Question of Law. No later than 91 days (13 weeks) before the trialAt any time after the last required pleading, with or without supporting affidavits, a party may move for determination of a question of law. If there is no genuine issue of any material fact necessary for the determination of the question of law, the court may enter an order deciding the question.

### Rule 56. Summary Judgment and Rulings on Questions of Law

## (a) - (g) [NO CHANGE]

**(h) Determination of a Question of Law.** No later than 91 days (13 weeks) before the trial, with or without supporting affidavits, a party may move for determination of a question of law. If there is no genuine issue of any material fact necessary for the determination of the question of law, the court may enter an order deciding the question.
