Mr. Morpew may appear in plain clothes provided the clothing is brought to the Alamosa County Jail no later than 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 2, 2025. His clothing may not include a belt, a necktie, shoelaces, or anything else that could be used as a weapon. The Alamosa County Sheriff's Office may reject any clothing it feels does not comply with this Order.

Furthermore, Mr. Morpew may appear in the courtroom without visible shackles but passive restraints such as a stun cuff shall be used. Mr. Morpew shall (through his attorneys) advise the Sheriff's Office of any medical condition (such as a pacemaker) that could cause him injury should a passive restraint device be activated. The Sheriff's Office may place Mr. Morpew in handcuffs or other restraints for transport when he is not in the courtroom.
