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Archuleta County Court judge finalists selected

Governor to appoint new county court judge

The Sixth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated two candidates for an Archuleta County court judgeship created by the appointment of the Hon. Justin P. Fay to the 6th Judicial District Court bench, effective Oct. 1, 2025. The commission selected nominees Anthony D. Edwards of Silverton and Matthew Gregory Margeson of Bayfield on Oct. 15, 2025.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Oct. 16, 2025, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Archuleta County.
