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Sixth Judicial District Court judge finalists selected

Governor to appoint new district court judge

The Sixth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship, following the retirement of the Hon. Chief Judge Jeffery R. Wilson, effective Jan. 2, 2026. Nominees Katie Ann Dittelberger of Durango, Anthony D. Edwards of Silverton, and R. Reid Stewart of Hesperus were selected by the commission on Oct. 15, 2025.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Oct. 16, 2025, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Sixth Judicial District (Archuleta, La Plata, and San Juan counties).
