Legal Description: The Animas Service Area is defined in the Original Decree as any point of diversion within the Animas River Basin (which includes the Animas River and all of its tributaries) upstream of a point on the Animas River that is located as follows: in the SW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 29, Township 35 North, Range 9 West, of the N.M.P.M., 1250 feet from the South Section Line and 720 feet from the West Section Line of said Section 29, La Plata County, Colorado. During diligence period, Pursuant to the requirements of the Original Decree, Applicant filed a notice of intent ("NOI") to develop an increment of the ASA Water Right to La Plata County ("County") and the Southwestern Water Conservancy District ("SWCD"). The NOI was assigned #54 and was approved by SWCD on May 5, 2025, and the County on May 12, 2025. The NOI was amended on November 11, 2025 to reflect a reduction in the irrigation acreage (down from .22 to .13) and approved by all parties as of November 19, 2025; it is attached hereto as Amended Exhibit 1. Pursuant to paragraph 6(e) of the Original Decree, the submission of the NOI entitled Applicant to divert water under the priority of the ASA Water Right to perfect this increment thereof. The Applicant has done so and has put the diverted water to beneficial use beginning on April 1 2025 through October 31, 2025 for the irrigation of turf lawn and trees for the residential property located at 115 Alamo Drive, Durango, CO 81301.
