ISSUE(S):

Whether the appellate court erred in reversing the trial court's Order re: Defendant City of Colorado Springs' Motion to Dismiss finding the deadline to provide notice under the Colorado Governmental Immunity Act ("CGIA") did not begin to run until the City of Manitou Springs informed her of the intergovernmental agreement that made the City of Colorado Springs potentially liable for her accident.
