

20TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT PROBATION ADULT INTEGRATED TREATMENT COURT (AITC)



WHAT IS AITC?

An intensive form of probation supervision designed to help with high risk, high need individuals who struggle with substance use addictions.

REQUIREMENTS

1. 2-year probation sentence which can be completed in as few as 15 months, but takes more like 18- 20 months.
2. Therapy 3 times per week on different days (2 groups, 1 individual).
3. Bi-weekly court reviews.
4. Bi-weekly probation meetings.
5. Frequent UA testing.
6. Full time schedule.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. Participants must live in Boulder County.
2. Participants must waive their right to use Marijuana, including medical.
3. Treatment team meets to discuss the participant's progress before each review.
4. The team will respond with either an "incentive" such as a gift card, or a "sanction," which has a wide range.
5. The team may also respond with a "service response".

AITC TREATMENT TEAM

The team consists of the Probation Officer, Judge, District Attorney, Public Defender, and Coordinator. The team can also sometimes include a Work Release representative, and Ready to Work representative.
