WHAT ARE THE STATE MANDATED CONDITIONS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROBATION?

- 1. Domestic Violence Evaluation:** You will be required to complete a Domestic Violence Evaluation and any recommended treatment. The Evaluation must be completed by a DVOMB approved treatment provider. You WILL be required to pay for the evaluation. Prices range from \$150-\$350. Please note, these price ranges are subject to change.
- 2. Domestic Violence Treatment:** If you are recommended for treatment, you will attend weekly groups and will be responsible for the cost of each group. Prices for groups range from \$25-\$50. Please note, these price ranges are subject to change.
- 3. Additional Services:** Depending on the results of the evaluation, you may be required to have a second treatment contact per week. This can include parenting classes, relapse prevention, anger management etc. You will be responsible for the cost of these groups as well, prices can vary. You may be required to submit random urinalysis based on your evaluation. Even if your case is not related to substance use, the evaluation may still require random urinalysis. Your Probation Officer and Treatment provider must agree to the frequency of random urinalysis testing. You will be financially responsible for the cost of urinalysis. Prices for urinalysis average \$24 per test, subject to change.

HOW LONG WILL I BE IN TREATMENT FOR?

There is not a set number of classes that must be completed to successfully discharge from Domestic Violence treatment. The number of classes that you attend is based on how you progress through competencies. Your treatment provider and Probation Officer will discuss how you are progressing through the competencies quarterly.

WHAT ARE OTHER CONDITIONS THAT COULD COME WITH DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROBATION?

Sentencing can include Substance abuse evaluation and recommended treatment, Mental Health evaluation and recommended treatment, anger management, parenting classes, community service, monitored sobriety, etc. You will be financially responsible for the conditions of your probation. It is important to start your conditions as soon as possible, so that these can be completed by your estimated discharge date. If conditions are not completed by your estimated discharge date, your Probation Officer may request an extension of your probation or file a complaint.

HOW OFTEN WILL I HAVE TO MEET WITH MY PROBATION OFFICER?

Depending on your supervision level, you may be required to appear for in-person meetings with your Probation Officer 2 times per month. Depending on your progress with your conditions of probation, supervision levels can be reduced, and meetings will be less frequent. Your probation Officer will discuss this with you during your first appointment.
