

20TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT PROBATION FEMALE SPECIFIC UNIT (FSU)



PROBATION IS AN OPPORTUNITY, NOT A PUNISHMENT

Probation helps you make positive changes in your life. The Female Specific Unit (FSU) offers gender-specific supervision and programs to help you meet your goals and follow court orders. FSU handles cases such as domestic violence, DUI, regular supervision, and intensive programs like WISE and AITC. You may be referred to special treatment groups or programs based on your case.

COURT ORDERS

The court will set specific conditions for you to follow, including:

1. Living a crime-free life (no illegal activity, weapons, alcohol, or drugs).
2. Submitting to drug monitoring.
3. Complying with treatment requirements.
4. Reporting for meetings (weekly, biweekly, or monthly).
5. Maintaining employment or education.
6. Updating Probation with address/contact changes.
7. Getting permission before leaving the state.
8. Paying fines, fees, and restitution.
9. Additional conditions may include community service, a MADD Victim Impact Panel, Restorative Justice Program, or a parenting class.

TREATMENT REFERRALS

The Court or your Probation Officer may refer you to treatment programs, including:

1. **Substance Abuse Treatment:** Outpatient or inpatient (usually covered by insurance).
2. **Mental Health Treatment:** Outpatient or inpatient (usually covered by insurance).

- 3. DUI Treatment:** Up to 24 hours of education and 86+ hours of therapy (may be covered by insurance).
- 4. Domestic Violence Treatment:** \$75-\$150 for intake, then \$25-\$35 per weekly group (usually lasts 24-30 weeks) and not covered by insurance.
- 5. In-House Treatment Groups:** Weekly groups like Women's Empowerment and Natural Highs, may be required for intensive programs (WISE or AITC).

SUBSTANCE ABUSE MONITORING

You will need to stay drug and alcohol-free during your probation. If you have a medical marijuana license, inform your Probation Officer (court approval may be required). Random drug and alcohol tests will be conducted, and you will need to pay \$24 per test. You must call daily to see if you need to take a test.
