YOU'VE BEEN SENTENCED TO PROBATION NOW WHAT?

1. **Intake & Assignment:** After sentencing, you'll meet with the Intake Unit in Boulder. A Probation Officer (PO) will then be assigned based on where you live.
2. **Contacting Your PO:** If you haven't heard from your PO, call the Boulder County Probation Office Front Desk to get their contact information.

YOUR FIRST MEETING

At your first appointment, you'll review and sign probation terms, including:

1. Maintain or seek employment (or provide proof of disability).
2. Keep your address and phone number updated.
3. No possession of guns or illegal weapons.
4. Submit to drug testing (\$24 per test) if required.
5. Allow searches of your person, home, or vehicle if necessary.
6. No non-prescription drug or alcohol use.
7. Get permission before leaving the state.
8. Report any new police contact or arrests.
9. Complete any required mental health or substance abuse treatment.
10. Sign releases for probation to communicate with treatment providers.

COURT-IMPOSED REQUIREMENTS

Your sentence may include:

- 1. Evaluations & Treatment:** Complete required mental health or substance abuse evaluations and follow treatment recommendations. Costs vary but may be covered by insurance, Medicaid, or Medicare.
- 2. Community Service:** Register with Boulder County Community Justice Services (\$100 fee) before starting service hours.
- 3. Payments:** Set up a plan with the court to pay fines and fees. Probation supervision costs \$50/month, plus additional court fees.

You are responsible for all probation-related costs unless the court states otherwise.
