ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2026-01
Amending Administrative Orders 2022-03 and 2022-05


Administrative order 2022-03 is hereby amended in the second paragraph, first sentence, to now read as follows:

Under the BHO program, all persons who are arrested and who arrive at the Montezuma County Jail between noon on Friday and 2:00pm on Saturday for most weekends, and who need a bond hearing under C.R.S. 16-4-102, will be seen by the BHO on Sunday mornings.

Administrative order 2022-05 is hereby amended in Section III, sixth paragraph, fourth sentence, to now read as follows:

If the defendant arrives at the detaining county jail between noon on Friday and 2:00pm on Saturday, the Dolores County Sheriff is responsible to provide the detaining jurisdiction with the time and contact information for the Dolores County's bond hearings before the BHO.
