<p>PARTIES' JOINT REQUEST FOR A STATUS CONFERENCE</p>	

In its March 5, 2026 Order, the Panel informed the parties that it was available to conduct the disciplinary hearing in this case from May 26-29, 2026. Unfortunately, Respondent's counsel is unable to accommodate those dates.

On March 26, 2026, the parties filed a Joint Case Management Order ("CMO"). The proposed CMO states that written discovery shall be completed no later than 60 days before the formal hearing in this case. This suggests that the formal hearing should be scheduled at least 90 days from the date this Panel issues the CMO.

The parties jointly request the Panel to schedule a brief status conference in this case to identify hearing dates. Given the number of schedules involved (three panel members, Judge MacLaren, and counsel for both parties), a brief status conference is the most efficient way to schedule the hearing. Because the proposed deadlines in the Joint Case Management Order are

dictated by the hearing date, it is important that the hearing date be scheduled promptly so that the parties can calendar the case and plan accordingly.
