<p><b>ORDER REGARDING RESPONDENT’S OBJECTION REGARDING THE COLORADO RULES OF JUDICIAL DISCIPLINE AND ORDER REGARDING SUBMISSION OF CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER</b></p>	

This matter come before the Adjudicative Judicial Discipline Panel (“the Panel”) on receipt of the parties’ filings. Having reviewed the matter, the Panel issues the following Order:

With no objection by the Commission, the Panel orders that the Rules of Civil Procedure shall govern the formal disciplinary hearing in this case.

Parties are ordered to exchange proposed Case Management Order’s seven days following the issuance of this Order. After proposed Orders are exchanges, parties are given seven days to confer as to any disputes in the CMO. If the parties are not able to resolve any disputes, the parties are to file their proposals at the expiration of the seven-day period.

Following the submission of the agreed-upon CMO or the disputed CMOs, the Court will schedule a status conference regarding the scheduling of the formal proceeding. For the parties’ information, potential hearing dates of May 26<sup>th</sup> through May 29<sup>th</sup> have been cleared for availability with the members of the Panel.
