



How to Guide to Confirmation Adoptions

1. Basic Information

- This process confirms who the parents are when using assisted reproduction.
- Both parents must complete and file the Petition together.
- The parents may file with the District/Juvenile Court in:
 - The county where the child was born or conceived.
 - The county where either parent lives.
 - Any county, if the child was born or conceived in Colorado.
- If the child was born in a Colorado hospital, the parents may have filled out a [form](#) to obtain an Acknowledgement of Parentage. If so, you may attach the Acknowledgment to the Petition.
- The law that directs this process is C.R.S. § 19-5-203.5.

2. Step-by-Step Guide

Step 1 – Start the Case

Both Petitioners

- 1) Complete the starting paperwork:

[JDF 1771](#) – Petition for Confirmation Adoption.

Attach: The child’s birth certificate.

Attach: Your marriage/civil union certificate (if during the child’s birth or conception).

[JDF 1772](#) – Confirmation Adoption Decree.

Note: Just do the **case caption**.

- 2) File with the District/Juvenile Court.

- 3) Pay the filing fee. See [Fees on page 3](#) for details.

Step 2: Hearing (*rare*)

All Parties

The court may hold a hearing. If so:

- 1) The Court will provide notice of the hearing date and time.
- 2) Be sure to arrive early to find the room and get through security.
- 3) The Court will review the paperwork, ask questions, and make a final decision on the case.

Step 3: Decree

The Court

The court will issue the decree within 30 days of starting the case.

3. Common Terms

Case Caption

The boxes at the top of the form. It contains the court's address, parties' names, the filer's contact information, and the case number.

Petitioners

The people filing the Petition; both adoptive parents.
