18th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected

Governor to appoint new district court judge

The 18th Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a new district court judgeship, created pursuant to SB25-024, effective July 1, 2026.

Nominees James Christopher Boeckx of Englewood, Niceta Elizabeth Bradburn of Parker, and Amy Danielle Touart of Centennial were selected by the commission on April 27, 2026.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from today to appoint one of the nominees as a district court judge for the 18th Judicial District (Arapahoe County).
