5th Judicial District County Court judge finalists selected

Governor to appoint new county court judge

The 5th Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a county court judgeship created pursuant to SB25-024, effective July 1, 2026.

Nominees Leslee K. Balten of Breckenridge, Joshua D. Savelkoul of Leadville, and Kristen M. Tarrin of Dove Creek were selected by the commission on April 22, 2026.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from today within which to appoint one of the nominees as a county court judge for the 5th Judicial District (Clear Creek, Eagle, Lake, and Summit counties).
