17th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The 17th Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by SB25-024, effective July 1, 2026. Nominees Thomas M. Ward of Lafayette, Marques Alexander Ivey and Lochlin Isaac Slifkin Rosen of Commerce City were selected by the commission on May 11, 2026.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from May 12, 2026, within which to appoint one of the nominees as a district court judge for the 17th Judicial District (Adams and Broomfield counties).
