Chief Judge Directive 17-03

Delegation of Authority:

This Chief Judge Directive supersedes any previous Chief Judge Directives or Orders that may exist relating to this subject.

Chief Justice Directive 95-01(2) permits The Chief Judge to delegate the authority for the day-to-day administrative operations of the district and county courts to the Court Executive, and permits The Chief Judge to delegate the responsibility of the probation department to The Chief Probation Officer.

Therefore, The Court Executive of the Eleventh Judicial District, shall be delegated the administrative authority for the district and county court personnel systems, budget and fiscal responsibilities and facilities and equipment.

The Chief Probation Officer of the Eleventh Judicial District shall be delegated the administrative authority for the probation department, personnel system, budget and fiscal responsibilities, and facilities and equipment.
