THIS MATTER having come before the Court upon notice and motion of the Defendant, Barry Morphey, and this Court finding good cause for the motion, the Court GRANTS the motion:

The prosecution is hereby ordered:

- (1) To preserve at least equal amounts of any evidence tested for defense testing;
- (2) To preserve all evidence with potential exculpatory or impeaching value;
- (3) Prohibited from any consumptive or destructive testing without prior notice to the defense and an opportunity for a hearing;
- (4) Required to return all evidence sent to other agencies for testing; and
- (5) Required to disclose of all chain-of-custody records and evidence storage logs.
