The prosecution has responded to eleven motions in one document, and Mr. Morphew has a similar response regarding each. Therefore, Mr. Morphew states:

1. For most motions, the prosecution agrees with Mr. Morphew or does not object to the relief requested.
2. In general, these motions are best resolved through a conference with this Court, the Jury Commissioner, and both parties. (Motion [D-029]). The prosecution does not oppose such a conference. In counsel's experience, many of the issues in these eleven motions can be resolved quickly at such a conference.

3. Mr. Morpew is moving for a continuance of trial and motions hearings. [Motion D-048]. As explained in that motion, his attorneys are not able to be ready for trial as currently scheduled. One result of the present circumstances is that his attorneys have not had time to review the prosecution's responses thoroughly to determine for which of the above motions a reply would assist the court and/or further preserve arguments. Thus, Mr. Morpew requests that this Court continue the jury procedures motions for a time closer to a newly-rescheduled trial.
