PARTIES JOINT NOTICE OF SUSPENSION	

Pursuant to paragraph 49 of the Stipulation for Public Censure and Suspension entered into on July 7, 2026, between the Colorado Commission on Judicial Discipline (“the Commission”) and Judge Ian MacLaren ("Respondent"), the undersigned parties hereby provide joint notice of the Respondent's suspension dates of August 3, 2026 through November 1, 2026.

1. On July 13, 2026, the Commission and Respondent entered into a Stipulation for Public Censure and Suspension (the "Stipulation") in the above-captioned matter.
2. The Adjudicative Judicial Discipline Panel ("the Panel") accepted the stipulation on July 20, 2026, noting "The Panel will issue the order for discipline in due course but intends to issue the order in advance of the August 31, 2026 date referenced in paragraph 49 of the parties' stipulation."
3. Paragraph 49 of the Stipulation provides for the suspension of Respondent from judicial office without pay for a period of 90 days. Judge MacLaren has consulted with judicial leadership, considered his docket, and the best interest of his judicial district. In scheduling an appropriate date for the discipline to begin, a senior judge is available to serve the district for the dates set forth below.
4. In accordance with Paragraph 49 of the Stipulation, and acceptance of the same by the Panel, the Parties agree that Judge MacLaren's suspension shall commence on August 3, 2026, and shall continue through November 1, 2026. Respondent will return to judicial office on November 2, 2026.
5. This agreement is not dependent on a written Order from this Panel, and instead, this Joint Notice is filed to inform the Panel of the effective dates of Respondent's suspension pursuant to the Stipulation and make these dates available to the Panel to the extent the Panel wishes to include them in a yet to be issued order for discipline.

CONCLUSION

The parties submit this Joint Notice of Suspension in fulfillment of their obligations under Paragraph 49 of the Stipulation for Public Censure and Suspension, with a 90-day suspension start date of August 3, 2026.
