[D-056] MOTION TO PROHIBIT RELEASE OF PRIVATE INFORMATION	

COMES NOW Barry Morphey, by and through counsel, and requests that this Court prohibit the Boulder County Sheriff's Office and any other law enforcement agency and the District Attorney from releasing identifying information and address(es) of private parties and in support, states:

1. The District Attorney has indicated that the Boulder County Sheriff's Office intends to release identifying information, including the address, of individuals not connected with this case.

2. Mr. Morphew was arrested at a residence where this Court ordered him to remain. That address belongs to private parties unconnected with this case.

3. Upon information and belief, there is a public safety risk to the individuals involved if their names and addresses are made public.

4. The Colorado Criminal Justice Records Act (CCJRA) provides that this Court may enter an order barring release of such information. See § 24-72-303 (1) (providing for release except as ordered otherwise).

5. The record of the arrest does not have to include the address of arrest. See § 24-72-302(1) ("the date and place that such official action was taken"). A report that Mr. Morphew was arrested "in Boulder" satisfies that subsection.

6. Mr. Morphew requests that the address of his arrest – a location he had been ordered to be by this Court – or his "last known address" – the same address – should not be released because of the public safety risk to the other residents at that address.

7. The prosecution has indicated that they take no position on this request.

WHEREFORE, Mr. Morphew requests an immediate order prohibiting release of identifying information including the address of the arrest or previous address of Mr. Morphew.
